We Remember is a forum for projects related to learning about the Holocaust.

The first to begin there is "**Kamarad23**," a unique creative way of learning about the Holocaust by creating the continuation of a youth magazine, "Kamarad" (Friend), that was written in Ghetto Terezin (Theresienstadt).

The Terezin ghetto was the only ghetto to survive until the end of World War II. Many childrens' and adolescents' artworks remained in the ghetto among them the poem "The Last Butterfly" that have become a symbol of the suffering of the Jewish child in the ghetto. Among the material was the "Kamarad", (friend), magazine that our project deals with and through which we tell the story of the life and death of its authors. The continuation of that article and of Kamarad itself comes nearly 60 years later in the "Kamarad23" project, in which youth in various communities worldwide have an opportunity to create the 23rd edition of Kamarad. Like the original magazine, "Kamarad23" is not intended just to look back but rather to look forward.
