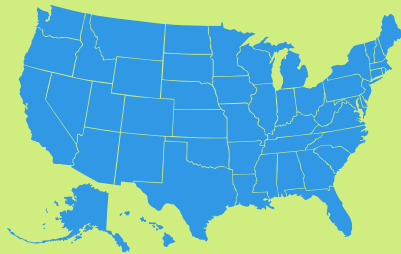
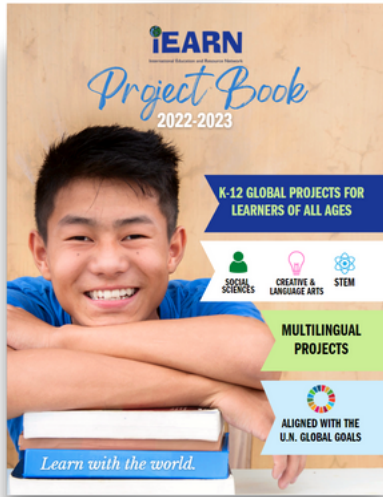
THE COLLABORATION CENTRE

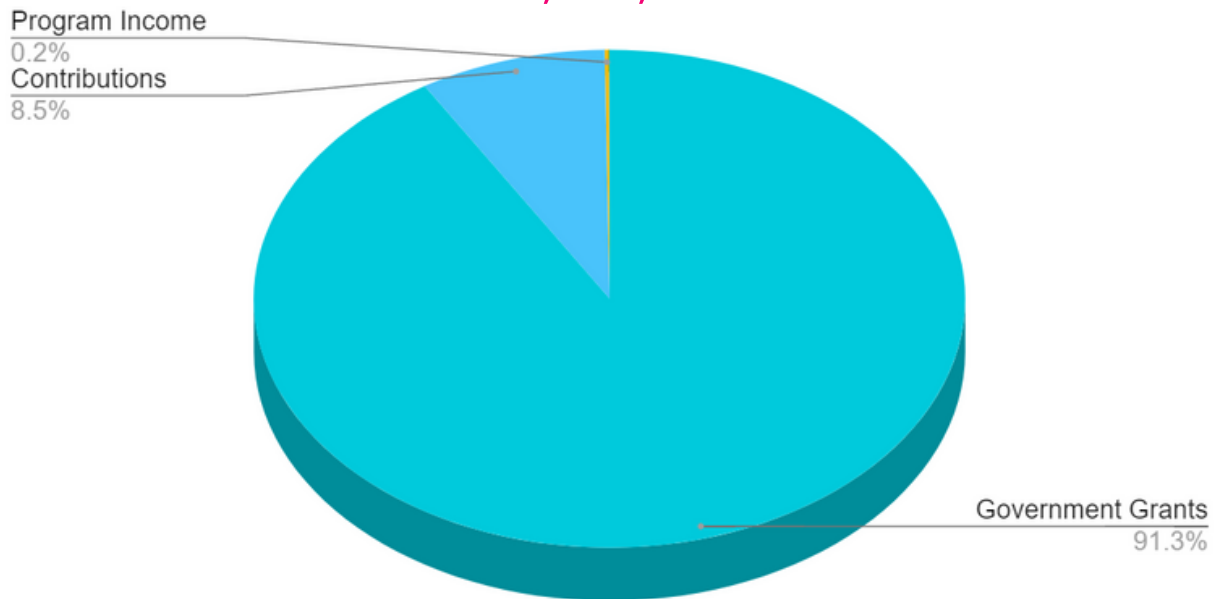

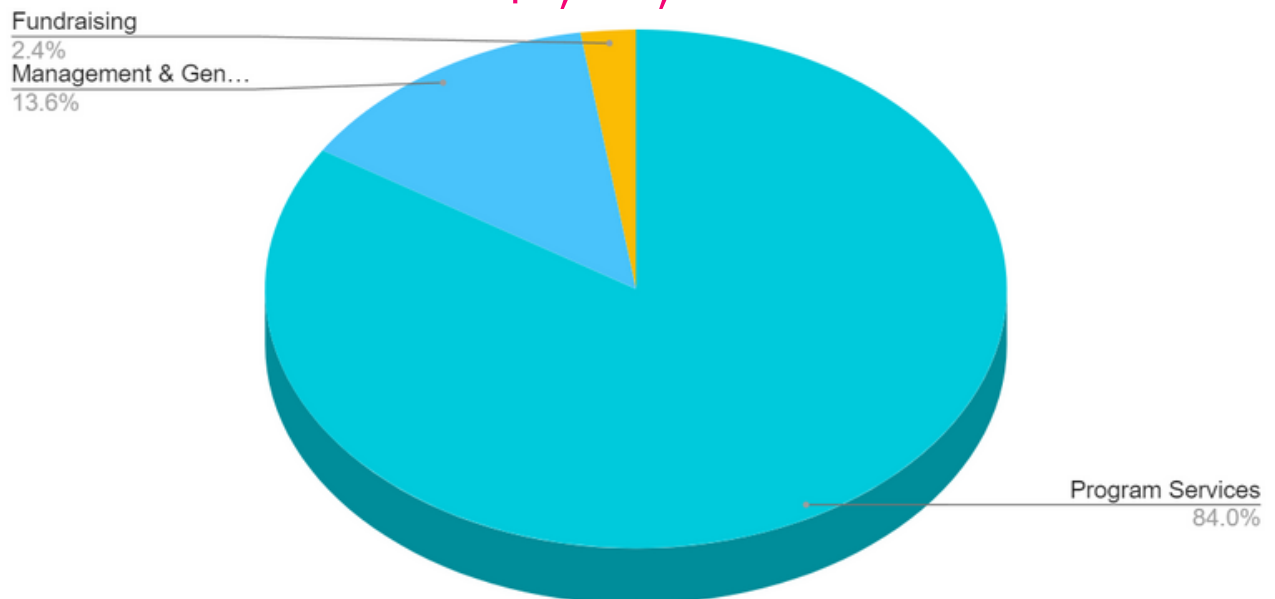
